#### **CCA Glide Waxing Protocol for All CATEGORIES**

All coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents must abide by the following protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in all age categories. (...) This also applies to athletes traveling to Alberta from out-of-province or out-of-country. The glide waxing protocol is as follows:

- Structure tools ARE permitted
- 2 Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted
- 2 Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted
- 2 Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, athletes, parents and wax technicians. "

## **Registration:**

**Risk of Cancelation:** This is an early season Alberta Cup and the event does run the risk of not having adequate snow to run a safe and fair race. Please stay tuned for updates on snow conditions as we get closer to the race date. Information will be published on the event and CCA websites.

#### How to Register and Enter the race

- Entries will only be accepted as on-line registration through the Zone 4 website at <u>www.zone4.ca</u> after November 1st, 2016.
- The Zone 4 website provides the opportunity for participants to confirm that their entry has been received.
- Payment must be made at the time of registration. Zone 4 only supports VISA and MasterCard.
- You are responsible for the accuracy of your points on any points list used for seeding, so to avoid disappointment, confirm points with the sanctioning body in advance of the deadlines.

#### Note – Trail Passes:

- All participants, (including racers, coaches, parent, volunteers) will be required to have a Canmore Nordic Center Pass. If you are on skis, at any time at the Canmore Nordic Centre you must have a trail pass. The fine for skiing without a pass is \$172.00.
- During the registration process, participants will be prompted to enter their season's pass number or purchase a day ticket at the discounted rate of \$7.50. Participants will not be able to complete registration without completing these steps.
- Additional discounted passes may be purchased for participants through registration and can be picked up in the race office
- A trail pass is also required for Official Training and must be purchased from the Nordic Centre ticket office.

#### Note for Coaches and Clubs:

• The ability to register a coach exists in Zone 4. **Coaches are encouraged to register** so that that Organizers can have an up to date contact list to distribute event communications.

#### **Eligibility and Licenses:**

Competitors in the Juvenile and older categories must have a CCC Racing License, FIS Racing License, Foreign National License, or a CCC Supporting Member Day License (SMDL). A SMDL must be purchased online while registering at Zone4.

#### **Race Entry Fees:**
