

## **Cancellation Policy for CNSC/RAD Club Camps and Races.**

*Updated January 2019*

### **Preamble**

The Canmore Nordic Ski Club is a non-profit. The club, on behalf of its members and in order to secure sites, hotels and camp locations such as Nipika, the Haig, and race events, at times, is required to provide a deposit up to a year in advance. In the event a family needs to cancel their child's participation for a camp or a race, the expenses such as accommodation, coach fees etc. are borne either by the club or the other participants. In order to be fair to all club members, to secure sites for club programming, and to ensure reasonable costs for all club participants, this cancellation policy has been created. This policy will address two types of scenarios (Scenario A and B), based on the length of time required to cancel and to ensure fair costs to all participants. They will be located in the banner at the top of the "**CNSC/RAD Camps & Races Schedule**".

### **Scenario A**

Participants cancelling **14 days to 8 days** before noon on the first day of the camp/race will be charged 50% of all club-incurred costs. Participants cancelling less than 8 days before noon on the first day of the camp/race will be charged 100% of club-incurred costs. Club-incurred costs could include, but are not limited to, accommodation, transportation, food, etc. In the case of camps or races with longer-term financial commitments, specific cancellation terms, in addition to those outlined above, will be communicated to participants and/or will be covered by **Scenario B**.

### **Scenario B**

In the case of camps or races with longer-term financial commitments.

Participants cancelling **60 days to 45 days** before noon on the first day of the camp/race will be charged 50% of all club-incurred costs. Participants cancelling less than 45 days before noon on the first day of the camp/race will be charged 100% of club-incurred costs. Club-incurred costs could include, but are not limited to, accommodation, transportation, etc. Examples for races or camps are Nipika, The Haig camp, Nationals, and other out of province camps and races.
